



COMMEMORATING PROJECT GEMINI

Tim Gagnon, portrait and graphic artist of Titusville, FL has created this commemorative design to honor the men and women who together put America into the lead in the space race. This will be an 8" patch partially embroidered patch. The area of "space" is black twill material to make the crew patch designs stand out. This was also the format of many Project Gemini mission patches.

The design celebrates every manned mission in the Gemini Program. The central focus is the Project Gemini symbol, a Roman Numeral II with two stars of the Gemini constellation indicating the two man crew. The Gemini symbol rises above the Earth and points the way to the Moon. The central theme of each crew's mission emblem surrounds the perimeter of this patch. Each crew member's surname is paired in the order in which they first flew. The surnames of the final prime crew pilots (Cernan, Collins, Gordon and Aldrin) are placed together as their commanders had already flown. The four smaller stars in the center honor Ted Freeman, Ed Givens, Elliott See and Charlie Bassett who were killed before they could fly in space.
